Because of her refusal or inability to stop, he and his wife asked her to leave home rather than give the example to their younger children. Michelle, the daughter, wandered and drifted and eventually joined the Hari-Krishna movement. "Father/Daughter" will air Wednesday, Sept. 1 at 7:30 p.m. on TV-10, on the ninth segment of 'Family Mat-

ters.' The film is an effective composite exploring the complex, but fascinating relationship of this father and daughter. "Black Perspective"

On The Campaign Trail

Georgia Congressman Andrew Young feels that America's Black people are more excited about Jimmy Carter than they have been about any Presidential nominee or incumbent since John Kennedy.

Young was the guest on the special hour-long edition of 'Black Perspective on the News' taped at its "Options '76" New York headquarters for nationwide broadcast on the last night of the Democratic Convention which will air Thursday, August 19 at 10 p.m. on Tv-10!

Other key Democratic figures interviewed on "Black Perspective on the News" during the Democratic Convention - Hubert Humphrey and Frank Church among them - echoed Young's praise for Carter's adeptness for harnessing Black support and, overall, took a hard look at the nominee's racial policies and his platform for the Black community.

In addition to the interviews with Young, Humphrey and Church, 'Black Perspective on the News' has begun production on two national specials slated for PBS broadcasting in the fall: one on Black political strategy in this election year and the other to feature network correspondents teamed up with program regulars for a cross-referential look at major national issues.

From its upcoming extensive coverage of the Republican Convention, 'Black Perspective' will broadcast an hour-long PBS special on the last night of the Convention, Thursday, Aug. 19 at 10 p.m.
