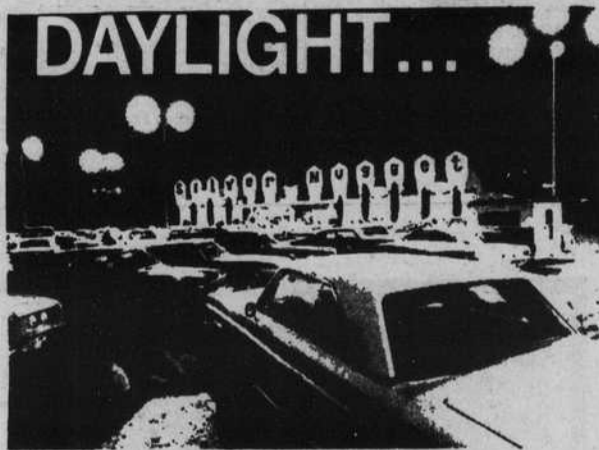

## Manhattans Walk Off With Platinum Single

It takes time to cultivate talent. Persistence and a belief in oneself can be that magic ticket to ride, then a break; the right time; the right producer, and of course, the right talent. Are the Manhattan's good? Just ask the first million who bought their single "Kiss and Say Goodbye," or maybe the second million, because the single has just been certified platinum by the R.I.A.A. (They are the second group in the history of R.I.A.A. certification to receive such a record). Finally after 12 years in the business, the Manhattans are carving their niches in popular music.



Time was when some of the best singing in New York City was heard not in the clubs or the larger halls, but in such picturesque and down home habitats as the local street corner and subway sto. And, oh those harmonies! If you were then a patron of the arts you might have heard individual members of the Manhattans giving some of their earliest performances. As youngsters, they all sang in rival groups only later to find mutual satisfaction with their current monicker.

Late in 1972 came that big break - an exclusive recording contract with Columbia Records, and a chance to work with multi-talented producer/arranger/composer Bobby Martin at Sigma Sound in Philadelphia. 1973's "There's No Me Without You" brought the Manhattans to a new audience and each successive release further strengthened the group's command of the charts.

The Manhattans are on the road making money. A sell-out stint with fellow Columbia powerhouse Johnnie Taylor has just been completed and things are going so well that an upcoming tour of Europe had to be pushed back. And another album is already in the works. Right now is the right time for The Manhattans.
