Sealed proposals will be received by the Directors of the Department of Highways of the State of Nevada at their office in the State Highway Building, Carson City, Nevada, until and opened at 1:30 p.m., Pacific Daylight Saving Time on October 7, 1976, for Contract No. 1607, Project No. FLH-TQF-095-1(1), construction of a portion of the Primary Highway System in Clark County, on U.S. Highway 95 between the junction with State Route 60 and the junction with U.S. Highway 93 (Railroad Pass), a length of 9.594 miles.

SPECIFIC DESCRIPTION OF WORK COVERED BY THIS CONTRACT CONSISTS OF: GRADING THE ROADBED, INSTALLING DRAINAGE STRUCTURES, CONSTRUCTING AN INTERCHANGE, PLACING GRAVEL BASE AND PLANTMIX BITUMINOUS SURFACE COURSES WITH A PLANTMIX BITUMINOUS OPEN-GRADED WEARING COURSE THEREON.

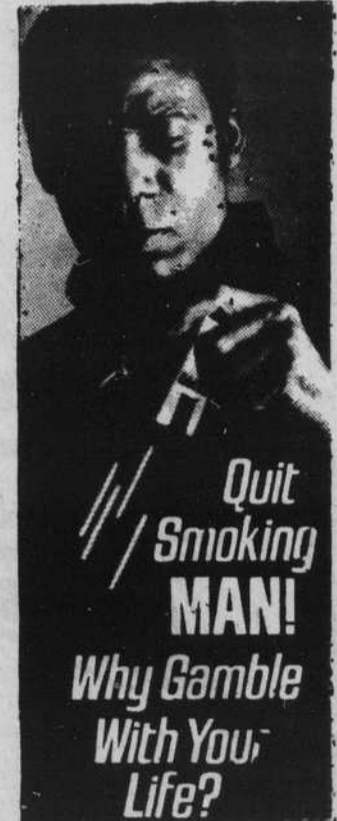
Geothermal Loan Guarantee

A Federal loan guarantee program to accelerate commercial development of geothermal energy is now in effect, according to Norm Melvin, geothermal coordinator for the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) in Nevada.

Melvin said the program, administered by the Energy Research & Development Administration (ERDA), is designed to help in the obtaining of loans for geothermal energy development by minimizing the financial risk to lending agencies.

"Because geothermal energy is a new, high-risk investment area, financing in some cases has been difficult to obtain. This loan guarantee program should alleviate that situation," he said.
