Goothermal Guarantee

A Federal loan guarantee program to accelerate commercial development of geothermal energy is now in effect, according to Norm Mel-vin, geothermal coor-dinator for the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) in Nevada.

Melvin said the program, administered by the Energy Research & Development Administration (ERDA), is designed to help in the obtaining of loans for geothermal energy development by minimizing the financial risk to lending agencies.

"Because geothermal energy is a new, high-risk investment area, financing in some cases has been difficult to obtain. This loan guarantee program should al-leviate that situation,"
