mending Richard Nixon for his re-election in 1972 - I voted against this resolution because I never liked Richard Nixon and I still don't! Candidates for public office must seek their employers permission to run -- I voted against this because it would have eliminated 99% of the Black people from seeking public office including myself.

Constitutional amendment against bussing -- I voted against this because I viewed it as a segregationist move to foil intergration of the school.

Using Tax Payer's money to pay narcotic informers -- I voted against this bill because it was my feeling that the state should use undercover agents who had badges and not endanger some addicts life by forcing him to inform. I place informers in the same catagory as a wiretap. This last bill should have meaning to my opponent.

It is my feeling that I did what the people elected me for, which was to use my judgement.

Now to the bills. It has been widely circulated that I only passed one bill in the whole time I served. This has been mentioned at one time or another by Bennett, Chaney, Terry, and Bailey. I don't hold any animosity toward these people because they want to get their man elected; but I think they would do their man more service if they would not lie on the other candidate. The truth of the matter is that over 60% of the bills and resolutions that I have been associated with have been passed into law. I'm proud to say that none of the bills or resolutions that I was associated with was against the Black community. Others who represent this area can not make this claim.

Permit me to bend your ear on another subject. Since the 18th of September, I have had five of my larger signs destroyed. We know who you are. We have photographed your footprints. There is a five hundred dollar fine for destroying political signs. If I catch you, don't worry about the fine.

The Rev. Bennett destroyed one my signs because as he said it was on his member's property - without her permission, which was true; but there was a "Howard Jones" sign there also without her permission which was not torn down when my sign was. When we pass Zion Methodist church and see that Bailey sign in the church yard, we know why.

The Voice reported some weeks ago that the e plan was to have certain individuals to join forces for my defeat. I see James Chaney is putting up signs for Bob Bailey. It makes me believe that was some truth to that statement in The Voice.

Have at it fellows, but remember when God is with you, you cannot be harmed.
