mending Richard Nixon for his re-election in 1972 - I voted against this resolution because I never liked Richard Nixon and I still don't Candidates for public office must seek their employers permission to run -- I voted against this because it would have eliminated 99% of the Black people from seeking public office including myself.

Constitutional amendment against bussing voted against this because I viewed it as a segregationist move to foil intergration of the school.

Using Tax Payer's money to pay narcotic informers -- I voted against this bill because it was my feeling that the state should use under cover agents who had badges and not endanger some addicts life by forcing him to inform. I place informers in the same catagory as a wiretap. This last bill should have meaning to my

It is my feeling that I did what the people elected me for, which was to use my judgement. Now to the bills. It has been widely circulated

that I only passed one bill in the whole time I served. This has been mentioned at one time or another by Bennett, Chaney, Terry, and Bailey. I don't hold any annomosity toward these people because they want to get their man elected; but I think they would do their man more service. if they would not lie on the other candidate. The truth of the matter is that over 60% of the bills and resolutions that I have been associated with have been passed into law. I'm proud to say that none of the bills or resolutions that I was associated with was against the Black community. Others who represent this area can not make this claim.

Permit me to bend your ear on another subject. Since the 18th of September, I have had five of my larger signs destroyed. We know who you are. We have photographed your foot prints. There is a five hundred dollar fine for destroying political signs. If I catch you, don't worry about the fine.
