"What audiences will see on 'Visions' will differ considerably in substance and style from week to week," Mr. Barbara Schultz, producer comments. "It is not something done by design,"

Ms. Schultz's comments fit precisely with the free-fold aim with which 'Visions' was conceived: to encourage new drama for television; to provide a continuing opportunity for American writers to write for television, and ultimately, to help in revitalizing American television drama.

What viewers will see on the first "Visions" -- "Two Brothers," a play by conrad Brom-berg, who has never written for television before -- tells the story of a young doctor who despite his older bro-ther's efforts to help him, is unable to cope with his own mental illness. "Two Brothers" will repeat Saturday, Oct. 23 at 11 p.m.

Madame Bovary

Gustave Flaubert's Bovary, Madame which shocked 19th century readers with its vivid portrait of a romantic adultress, will be seen on TV-10's Mas-terpiece Theatre for four successive weeks beginning Sunday, Oct. 10 at 9 p.m. and repeat-ing Monday, Oct. 11 at a new early evening time for public broadcasting

Playing the tragic heroine who set tongues wagging as she tried to escape the boredom of marriage in the arms of other men is Francesca Annis, who won the N.Y. Drama Critics Award for her portrayal of another classic tragic heroine -- Ophelia in Ni-chol Williamson's "Hamlet."

Its 50-year-old author who worked on the book for almost five years, was condemned for the subject matter, and at the same time praised for the honesty and skill with which he handled it. The TV dramatization has drown nothing but praise.

"paradise in his mind." And although Gavin's search and his career in music are serious ones, it is also joyfully apparent that it's possible to dance his way down the road he's chosen, taking a lot of happy people along with him.
