

Crisis in the Churches

Recent burning of churches (4 at this writing) has created a crisis out of propotion. Fire insurance companies are threatening to cancel fire policies in our area. This would make it all but impossible to finance further church buildings or improvements. However there is a U.S. government program which will provide not only fire but burglary & theft through the The Fair Plan, but of course the rates are considerably higher as this is similar to the assigned risk of automobile policies -- but it can be obtained.

Burnings in the white areas will produce the

same results. It thus becomes important to band together in this situation for the mutual benefit. I have been advised that the white ministers have a Ministerial Alliance and blacks are invited to join. This is good, but it is to be hoped that this problem will cause a formation of a solid Black Ministers Alliance, since their problems are different.

It was beautiful to see on TV a cross sectio of our ministers entering a meeting with Sheriff Lamb in an effort to stop the church burning. Progress is the child of crisis.

I have long noted the tremendous power the 70,000 black churches could wield. Tie them in

70,000 black churches could wield. Tie them in with other black oriented groups like NAACP, SCLC, A. Phillip Randolph, Black Panther, Operation Life, etc. and the potential is unlimited. In Dr. J. H. Jackson's annual address of 1962 called "Another Milestone on the Road from Protest to Production" he stated: "The next forward step in racial development and progress will not be made by our white friends for their negro neighbors, but will be made by negroes for themselves. And this step depends not on what negroes can force others to give not on what negroes can force others to give or do for them, but what negroes in the light of new opportunities will do for themselves and for the social order in which they live.

We then must possess a new courage to face frankly the failures and short comings in our local community, and address ourselves with boldness to the correction of the same; for it takes far more courage to face the personal problems in our own lives and those in our immediate families and communities, than it does to analyze the short comings of those who oppose our growth and development. We must go from protest to production."


Let us move forward.
