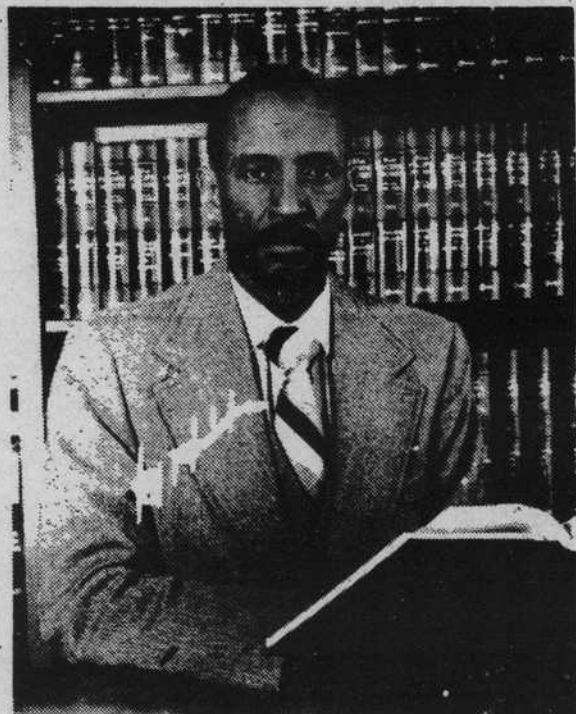

All area attorneys are invited to attend and should make reservations by Oct. 22 by calling the ACLU office at 386-4837.

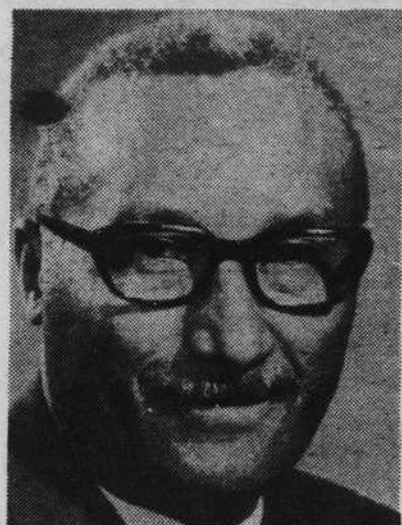
NAACP Given Time to Raise Bond

Having won a temporary injunction in a Federal District Court postponing the bond deadline on the \$1.25 million judgment, the NAACP launched a new phase in its funding drive to raise \$2 million before the end of the year.

NAACP Board Chairman Margaret Bush Wilson and Administrator Glostel B. Current said that there was a real danger that the public would be misled into believing that the crisis was over.

That is not so - Judge Orma R. Smith for the Northern District of Mississippi merely stopped the clock by issuing a 10-day restraining order against the posting of a \$1.6 million bond and other legal actions in the state courts.

So far, the NAACP has raised approximately \$800,000 in contributions which came mostly in contributions and loans through NAACP branches, churches and private groups.

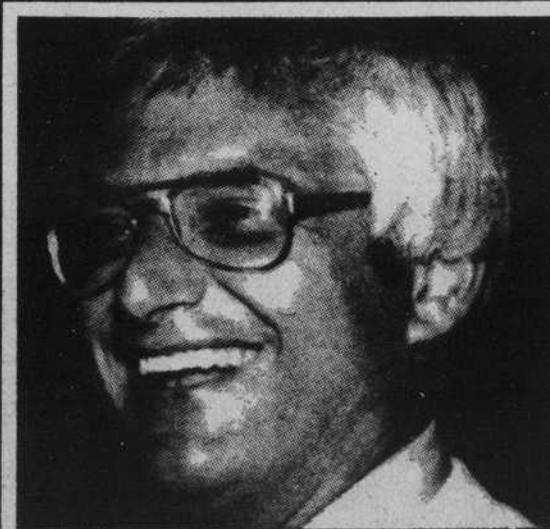
