PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Sophomore Russ Strecker and senior Chris Davis have been selected the defensive and offensive players-of-the-week for their play in JNLV's 31-26 triumph over Boise State last Saturday night in Las Vegas by the Rebel coaching staff.

Strecker, 6-4, 217, is the Big Red left end while Davis, 6-1, 257, is the left guard on the potent Rebel offensive unit. Both players are two of the more consistent on the 7-2 UNLV team this season.

From Englewood, Colorado, a suburb of Denver, Strecker has his finest games of his young career and he had to do it under intensely adverse conditions. Not only did he have to play both the positions because right-end Tim Melcher went down with an ankle injury, he was trying to defend against Boise quarterback, who was the finest scrambler the Rebels have played against all year.

The result for Strecker was four tackles and three assists, but most importantly, he put tremendous pressure on the Boise quarterback and had two quarterback sacks in the game.

Assistant UNLV head coach Doug Carder commented, "Russ has been one of our most consistent defensive players this season. He works very hard to improve himself each day in practice. Against Boise, he executed his assignments to near perfection, and pressured Boise's passing attack all evening. He is a very versatile

athlete and this ability will help us in the final part of the 1976 season."

Davis is one of the strongest players ever to wear a Rebel uniform and literally intimidates his opponent on the line of scrimmage. Against Pacific this season, he even fulfilled a lineman's dream -- he scored a touchdown by recovering a Raymond Strong fumble in the end-zone.

The Rancho High product is a three-year letterman and started and was complimented by offensive line coach Ron Smeltzer, "Chris plays a very physical game week after week. He has been very intimidating to opposing defenses, playing well against a very physical Boise team. Against BSU, he eliminated the mental errors which have held him back from receiving the player of the week award before this game."
