THE EMPLOYMENT AREAS

Today some 15 million people are employed by some arm of government. This means that one out of every five persons receives his or her pay check from a government body. State and local governments account for four times as many employees as the federal government. Unfortunately, most state and local employees have seniority-based job security and many of these non-federal government bodies face a cash flow failure similiar to that experienced by New York city. This leaves the federal government - which can print money - and industry as the main new employment areas.

President-Elect Carter presented economic policies of cautious expansion that might min-

President-Elect Carter presented economic policies of cautious expansion that might minimize the danger of explosive inflation during the campaign. The rate of inflation projections for 1977 is less than five percent under President Ford's slow growth national economic plan.

This is an exceptable policy to white working people. However, the U.S. economy will not be able to generate a great number of new jobs for the last hired and the first fired group under this slow growth economic plan.

Capital spending for new plant development has just begun to slightly increase. This will have a slight stimulus to the U.S. economy in the latter part of 1977. Consumer spending which is the bigger part of the economy is dragging the ground. Retail sales are unduly slow and savings are on the increase.

The United States League of Savings Associations, reports that last year the average American saved 8.3 percent of his disposable income or for \$83 for ever \$1,000 he made after taxes. The economy needs and injection of those collars to get itself going on the upside.

The economy is not getting this security surplus. Consumers are simply not confident of the current projected recovery of the promises of President-Elect Carter.

Congress has seen the light. By over-riding President Ford's veto of the job bill act, a projected 300,000 jobs will be created next year. Blacks must not allow these jobs to by-pass them.
