

## Consumer Survival Kit on **Sporting Goods**

Americans spend close to a million dollars a day on sporting goods. This week's Consumer Survival Kit, airing Sunday, November 28 at 6 p.m. on Channel 10, offers advice on tennis and golf equipment, skis and bikes that will help complement your hobby without insulting your budget. The quiz of the week discusses several types of golf clubs, the safety factor in bicycles, and inexpensive wood racquets.

Choosing and buying a tennis racquet requires knowledge prior to purchase time, noting the importance of weight and balance, flex, grip size, stringing, and the advantages and disadvantages of wood, metal or composite racquets.

She also discusses their size, the weights, components, safety, price and packaging. Close to 700,000 bikes were stolen last year alone, and the segment stresses the importance of bike locks, emphasizing types and costs.

Buying ski equipment is the third focus of the evening. Tests that can be made when buying skis are demonstrated and the composition and costs of skis is discussed. An important follow up focuses on ski boots, their construction, fit, and cost.






## **WOMEN'S VOLLEYBALL**
