Vehicle Registration Renewals Due

CARSON CITY -- If your Nevada vehicle license expires this month, you are urged by the Department of Motor Vehicles to apply for your 1977 registration renewal sticker now and to make your application by mail.

Freddie Little, the Departments Deputy-Director said, "The deadline for December registration renewals is the 31st and there is no grace period in Nevada."

"The renewal process should be handled by mail and a check or money order sent for the proper fees," Little continued. "You may apply for renewal to a Department Branch Office in Washoe or Clark Counties or in the other counties to the Assessor's office in the county of your residence."

Civil Service Commission Now Accepting Applications

The United States Civil Service Commission is now accepting applications from individuals interested in summer employment with Federal agencies, for jobs as clerks, typists, stenographers and engineering and survey aids. Written test is required.

Applicants interested in early consideration should file prior to the first test in January.

Jobs for lifeguards, aids or technicians in forestry, fire control, recreation, range and resource conservation do not require a written test.
