UNLV RUNNIN' REBELS HIT THE ROAD

After extending their home court winning streak to 42, the nationally ranked Runnin' Re-bels of UNLV hit the road this week for a pair of games against rugged competion. Coach Jerry Tarkanian's team is 3-0 after opening its home season with wins over the University of Oregon, 78-67, and Iowa State University, 115-80. The Runnin' Rebels will be in Salt Lake City Tues-day night to meet the 1-1 University of Utah Redskins and on Saturday, UNLV will challenge San Diego State University in the only college game of the season scheduled in the spacious San Diego Sports Arena. The Runnin' Rebels are averaging 98.3 points per game after the season's first three games are giving up only 78.0 for a winning margin

are giving up only 78.0 for a winning margin of 20.3 points per game. Senior forward Glen "Gondo" Gondrezick is leading the Runnin" Rebels in both scoring and rebounding as the hot-shooting UNLV squad is scorching the nets for a team field goal per-centage of .512 and an even more impressive .802 percentage from the free throw line. A 6-6 senior from Boulder, Colo., Gondo is averaging 17.0 points per game and 9.3 rebounds on an average.
