
Q -- I was honorably discharged in May 1969 and have no intentions of using my VA educatio-nal benefits. May I transfer them to my child ren?

A -- No. However, if you are rated 100 per c-ent permanent and totally service-connected dis-abled, your children would be eligible for depen-dents' educational assistance.

Q -- I have a 10 per cent service-connected di-sability and receive \$38 monthly compensation. I will be 65 years old next month and I will be eligi-ble for nonservice-connected pension. May I re -

ization?

A -- Yes. On a space-available basis, provid-ed the veteran has other than a dishonorable di charge. Veterans having a service-connected disability receive priority for admission.
