A Memorial to Dr. Ralph J. Bunche



Peace Form One will be a sculptured 50 foot stainless steelobelisk. It will be a major art work and memorial to Ralph J. Bunche. Nobel Peace Prize winner and former Under Secretary of the United Nations.

This striking monument to a great American will be erected in United Nations Park near the Isaiah Wall, and was conceived in memory of Dr. Bunche as a symbol of man's renunciation of war and corruption.

Artist Daniel LaRue Johnson, friend and protege of the statesman, formulated the model for Peace Form One which has been enthusiastically received by the U.N. Arts Committee, the Visual Arts Committee of the City of New York, and the family and friends of Dr. Bunche.

The erection of Peace Form One in one of New York's public parks will contribute importantly to the artistic and cultural vitality of the city. It will combine the beauty and timeliness of art with perspectives of historical greatness, hope for future prosperity, and peace. It will be a tribute to Ralph J. Bunche whose illustrious career was a dedication to these achievements.
