

Our new President James B. McMillan officiated at the first regular meeting of the Las Vegas Branch of the NAACP on March 13, 1977. More than 50 persons heard commit-tee reports that included Otis Harris' comments on the new Westside Economic Deve-lopment; Nevada Equal Rights Commission got full coverage from Jesse Scott . . . he said "Big things are going to happen - not only for Blacks, but for all people that are discriminated against."

discriminated against." Mabel Hoggard gave a report on the West-side Federal Credit Union, (418 Madison, Las Vegas, Nevada - 648-4626) and asking for members for the Education Committee for "PROJECT SAVINGS" (George Simmons is the Project Manager). She asked, "Won't you o-pen a little account (\$5.25) for your child at the Westside Federal Credit Union .... Then make a weekly deposit (as little as 10¢ will be accepted). If properly nourished, this lettle account will GROW into a College En-trance Fee." trance Fee."

Dr. Porter L. Troutman, Jr. reported on the Teacher Corps - College of Education -- Uni-versity of Nevada, Las Vegas. He stated, "Parents are invited to participate and pro-vide imput in designing an effective educational program on a voluntary basis. There is greater attention to career education so that students will be prepared for the world of work -- for the realities."

Dr. Troutman goes on to say, "Young men and women (interns) are recruited and placed in a training program -- training aimed at the actual needs of teachers. To place more concentrated emphasis on the quality of teachers already serving in the schools, a team of Teacher Corps interns are assigned to work

with the entire teaching staff of the school in an integrated program of training." The next regular meeting will be April 10, 1977 at 4:00 P.M., 1040 West Owens Avenue, Las Vegas, Nevada.
