For eight years, the poor women of this community have been banned together to help provide a better life for themselves, their children, and others like them. All colors and creeds have been working to the same end - to provide the basic necessities of life and to provide an alternative to the welfare of life and to provide an alternative to the welfare

cycle that they have endured.

They have worked hard to bring service programs to Nevada that the State did not want them They struggled to urge the State to bring in food stamps, they fought for health care, and for food services, jobs, economic development. And they

were successful.

They operated their own health clinic on Jackson Street to provide early periodic screening —
they provided the WIC program to give pregnant
and nursing mothers and their children under 5
high nutritious foods so they would be healthier.
Did you know that the Women of Operation Life
wrote the State plan for the WIC program 22 They wrote the State plan for the WIC program?? That was because Nevada was the only state that did not plan to participate in this 100% rederally financed program. Against all odds in a City of odds, we were told we could not do it. But we were postrively operating against the odds.

Well, the State could not handle that. They have proceeded to take the Early Screening program from the women who brought it to the community and who MADE SURE THAT PEOPLEWERERECEIVING ADEQUATE HEALTH CARE. Now the State and the men at the top are working again to see that the women of Operation Life are totally without the programs they want so desperately for their community.

They have hired a brave and retired service man who receives two salaries. One from the Federal government as retirement pay and one from the State of Nevada. Plenty huh? And this to tell poor women that they don't understand the litty gritty. He feels that Operation Life's biggest problems is that they care about the people they are serving. Well, this man is not brave enough and strong enough to stand man is not brave enough and strong enough to stand up against the real power hungry politicians that are after Operation Life. His name is Ron Lange, he works for the Nevada State Health Department in Carson City, and he has about as much feeling for poor people and social programs as a hungry rattlesnake that's curlled and ready for attack. As nonpolitical State jobs are supposed to be, he is thriving in the wrong business. he is thriving in the wrong business.

Yes, the State is after the WIC program now. The men working for the State who are making big salaries playing fun and games - and they are political. Next week I'll say more. When they first took the Early Screening Program, I wasn't sure what they were really after, but things are getting clearer and clearer, and I'll be letting you know just what's in the works for poor Las Vegans, Operation Life and the next major political election.

Thanks to Assemblyman Lonnie Chamey who stood up in opposition to AB 89 of the Nevada State Legislature. The bill would penalize welfare women who get married and severely hurt their families. For instance, if a woman gets married or if she just decides to live with some man, the man must take total responsibility for the financial care of that famtal responsibility for the financial care of that family. Suppose the man makes minimum wage (or less ily. Suppose the man makes minimum wage (or less) and trys but can't support the family. He will be forced to leave the home so that the children can be fed. This has been a major problem for the forced to leave the home so that the children can be fed. This has been a major problem for the whole welfare system. It breaks up-the home, causes more expenses to the Welfare Department and severely hurts children. But leave it to George to make more expense for the Welfare Department and hurt families. I mean that man couldn't be more harmful to the Welfare Department and to people if he tried. He is bad, all the way through. Thank you Assemblyman Channey for standing up for your community and behalf of all the poor families that need a spokeman in the assembly.


