



Las Vegas Attorney Gary White filed March 28, 1977 for the office of Municipal Court Judge. Calling for a return of even-handed justice and respectability to the municipal bench, White filed in Department 4.

White, UCLA Law School graduate, is former Clark County Deputy Public Defender. In 1970-1972, while in law school, he assisted in establishing the Black Law Center in Los Angeles, and worked on an internship basis in the Public Defender programs of Washington, D.C., and Anchorage, Alaska. Upon graduation from UCLA, he served for two years as Reginald Heber Smith Fellow assigned to Community Action Legal Service in New York City.

While an appointee on the staff of Attorney General Robert List in 1974, White founded the Carson City Pee Wee Wrestling program. As coach of the grade-school youngsters, he drew on his experience as an all-conference wrestler at UCLA, and winner of California's State High School Wrestling Championship in 1963.

White's community activities in Las Vegas include serving as a director of the annual "D" Street Festival, as well as Vice-President of the Las Vegas Jazz Society. "The members of the Jazz Society were particularly happy to be instrumental in helping the UNLV Jazz Band tour Europe recently," he stated.

A member of both State and Federal Bars in California and Nevada, White, 31, has been associated during the past year with Michael Hines in the private practice of law. He resides at 605 Princeton, Las Vegas, Nevada.

The Nevada Women's Conference will present a series of mini conferences throughout Nevada in April.

The project is funded by the Nevada Humanities Committee, which provides grants to non-profit organizations for the purpose of discussions of public issues.

"To Form a More Perfect Union: Issues For Nevada Women" will present public policy issues for discussion in the areas of women in health, women at home, and women in the work force.

The series will be held April 18 through 21 in Tonopah, Carson City, Fallon, Northeast Reno, Winnemucca, Elko, Ely and Caliente.

Jean Ford, Coordinator of the Nevada Women's Conference will serve as moderator for the series. Other panelists will include Dr. Eleanor Bushnell, Bob Clark, Renee Diamond, Fawn Dixon, Mary Frazzini, Josephine Gonzales, Paul S. Hanna, Ann Howard, Dr. Rosemary Masek, and Dr. Roman Zorn. Mary Forrester is the director of the project.

The Nevada State Coordinating Committee is composed of thirty three Nevada women appointed by the National Commission on the Observance of International Women's Year.
