You would be shocked at how many children of our community have some health problem that they need to take care of before it is too late. It is a matter of

I keep stressing the importance of high nutritional foods also, and I urge you to have your child receive milk, cheese, eggs, fruit juices and other good foods. The natural gas problem has been compounded because some electric and gas utilities companies, chief fuel, natural gas, is being allowed to run short. These utilities companies are moving away from the use of natural gas. Many of their new energy generating plants will run on coal or nuclear energy.

These plants are much costlier to build than natural gas plants so will force higher home heating cost on to the consumer. Exxon, adding insult to injury, will, without Congress passing an oil divestiture act, be there to hike up the home heating bill still further when the utility companies come calling for nuclear fuel.
