Attention of bidders is particularly called to the requirements as to conditions of employment to be observed and minimum wage rates to be paid under the contract.

Bid proposals must be submitted on the form provided by Clark County and accompanied by a proposal guaranty in the form of cash, or a certified check, cashier's check, money order or a bid bond in favor of Clark County in the amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the bid price.

All bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope plainly marked, "Bid No. 674-77, Waterline and Trenching," with the name and address of the bidder in the upper left hand corner and accompanied by complete specifications for the item offered.

The successful bidder shall furnish, at his own expense, a Faithful Performance Bond, a Payment Bond and a Guarantee Bond in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price. All bonds shall be from an acceptable surety company and shall be licensed in the State of Nevada.

The term "Owner" as used throughout the documents if invitation to bid shall mean the County of Clark, Las Vegas, Nevada whose representatives shall administer and supervise the work in accordance with terms and conditions of a grant agreement between the Economic Development Administration shall review all contract documents and authorize further action.

All terms and conditions contained in the contract documents shall become a part of the contract.

The Affirmative Action Plan must be in strict conformance with provisions of the Equal Opportunity bid conditions or bids will be rejected for nonresponsiveness.

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CLARK COUNTY HEALTH DISTRICT

A cervical cancer screening program for women sponsored by the Nevada State Health Division in cooperation with the Clark County Health District is currently underway, according to Mrs. Evelyn McColl, Deputy Health Officer for the Health District.

The screening includes a "pap" test for cervical cancer, and breast examination. If necessary, referrals will be made for appropriate followup. Appointments are now being accepted at the Health District at 625 Shadow Lane; call 385-1291 extension 231. The program is available at no cost.

It is especially important for women over 35 to have a yearly "pap" test. Women who have a family history of cancer are also urged to get yearly checkups. One out of thirteen women will develop breast cancer. Early detection is of primary importance in the control of this disease.

The Economic Opportunity Board also provides the cancer screening program under the same state sponsorship.
