Alice Negratti, director of the University College academic programs, said students should call now to arrange for an appointment. Counselors will be assisting students with class scheduling and academic advisement from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. weekdays in the University College.

She said students who planned their schedules with university counselors during recent visitations to the high schools must still complete their registrations. Deadline is August 12 for students to pick up their class cards and pay fees.

Also, freshmen have until July 15 to file for admission to UNLV if they intend to take more than six credit hours in the fall, Negratti said.
