

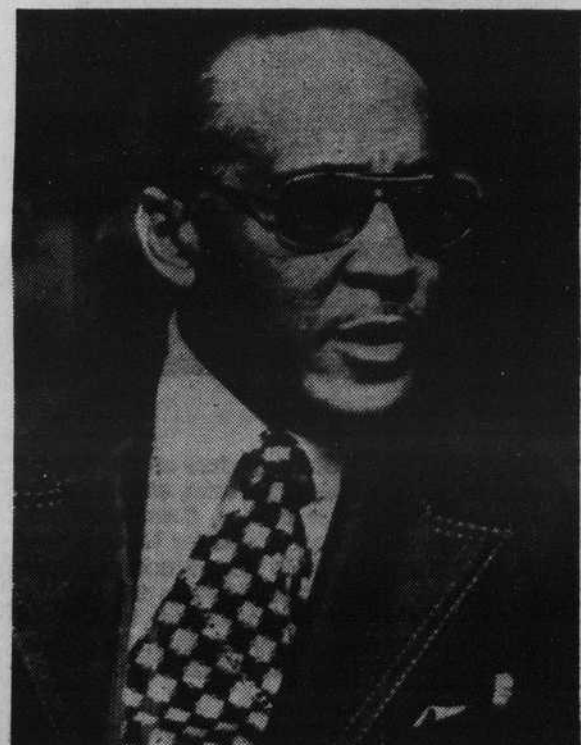
ALEXANDER ARON MORGAN

At Talladega College he graduated with the degree of Bachelor of Arts, continued his studies at B. F. Lee Theological Seminary of Edwards Waters College in Jacksonville, Florida, graduating with a Bachelor of Divinity Degree. In each of his pastorates, he worked for the improvement of his Church and community throughout Missouri, Kansas, Arizona, and California coming to Pasadena in 1969. First A.M.E. Church was revived spiritually and physically during the 5 years of Brother Morgan's ministry there. Dr. Morgan was appointed by Bishop Harrison J. Bryant, as presiding Elder of the Southern California conference in 1974. Presently he is serving the Los Angeles and San Diego District with a total of 26 Churches. June 1976 he was awarded honorary Doctorate Degree from Edward Waters College Florida. He is married to the former Wilma Brooks of Kansas City, Kansas and the father of six children.

Dr. Morgan will be in the company of Bishop Brookins, 91st Bishop of the African Methodist Episcopal Church, 5th Episcopal District.

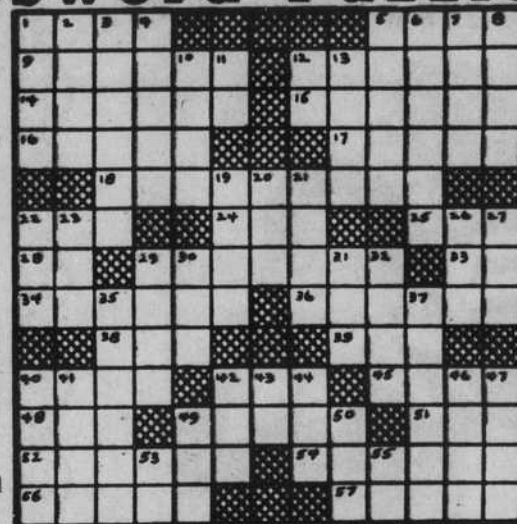

BISHOP H. HARTFORD BROOKINS, D.D.

(91st Bishop of the African Methodist Episcopal Church) born in the state of Mississippi holds many Degrees, such as a Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor of Divinity, and Doctor of Divinity. Bishop Brookins has been involved in Civic, Social, Political and Humanitarian projects, stretching from Kansas to California.

Presently he is national chairman of the Board of Operation Push, member of the national Board Southern Christian Leadership Conference, Life membership NAACP, member of the Board of Directors, Bank of Finance. Member of Board of Directors DIDI Hersch Mental Health Clinic, together with other prestigious boards and organizations. He serves as chief consultant to the Governor of California, EDMUND G. BROWN, JR., and numerous other Congressmen and Senators from the State of California.

Served the A.M.E. Church in Central Africa from 1972-1976, built a 100 unit Housing development, church sponsored, first of its kind in Central Africa. Served in Zambia, Rhodesia, Malawi, Tanzania, Zaire. Was invited by the Government of Tanzania as an official spokesman, and as such led the north American Delegation to the 6 Pan African world Congress held in DAR ES SALAAM, Tanzania 1974.

Presently serving as presiding Bishop of the 5th Episcopal District, which covers the 13 Western States of the United States. Will be principal speaker Sunday July 10th at 3 p.m., the Gold Room, Las Vegas Convention Center.
