Excellent season tickets to the University of Nevada, Las Vegas Rebel football games are available now to both UNLV students and the general public, according to Marilyn Workcott, spokesperson for the university athletics department.

Tickets for the general public are selling for \$36 a seat, while students with proper UNLV identification have the opportunity to buy them at a reduced rate of \$18 each. Because of the special price, however, a two ticket limit is being enforced upon students. "We are able to accommodate even more student Rebel fans this year with the special rates," says Scott Lorenz, president of the Consolidated Students of the university (CSUN)

Approximately 4,000 tickets are selling for the student rate.

Season tickets, which are sold on a first come, first served basis, can be purchased in the UNLV athletics office, located in the physical education plant on Harmon Road from 9 a.m. through 5 p.m. weekdays a.m. through 5 p.m. weekdays.
