BLOOD DONORS

Central Telephone Company employees do-nated 327 pints of blood to the community during a two-day blood drive at two com-pany locations last week.

John Schwartz, Director of Blood Services, said it was the largest company collection this year, and came at a time when it was vitally needed. During the summer months regular donors usually go on vacation and supplies of blood fall below comfortable levels.

The staff of Blood Services worked into the early morning hours to process the record total of blood for use in area hospitals. After the blood is classified, tested and processed, it is stored in refrigerated containers. The blood is separated into its components during processing, to provide more efficient

For example the red cells can be trans-fused to a patient undergoing vital surgery while the plasma can go to a burn victim. The blood was collected at the company's

warehouse complex on Spring Mountain Road, and at their 601 Fremont Street offices. The drive was organized by Centel's Industrial Nurse Doris Hinderliter.
