ATLANTA -- A plan to raise \$1,000,000 over the next two years for the NAACP, National Urban League, and the United Negro College Fund was unveiled today by James R. Williams, General President of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc.

The \$1,000,000 drive, undertaken by the nation's oldest black Greek letter organization, was announced at the public meeting at the Fraternity's 71st anniversary convention this week in Georgia at the Atlanta Hilton Hotel. Attending the convention was Benjamin L. Hooks, NAACP Executive Director.

Founded at Cornell University in 1906, Alpha Phi Alpha has about 70,000 members. These are college trained men from over 500 college and alumni chapters in 44 states, the West Indies, Africa, and Europe.

Mr. Williams said of the campaign: "This is the most broadbased effort of its kind in the nation. Its purpose is both to raise money and to rally the top black leadership of America to a new level of support for these three organizations which are so vital to the expansion of opportunity for Afro-Americans. Alpha Phi Alpha's long commitment to the development of America for full and equal opportunity for black people will be greatly advanced through this effort."

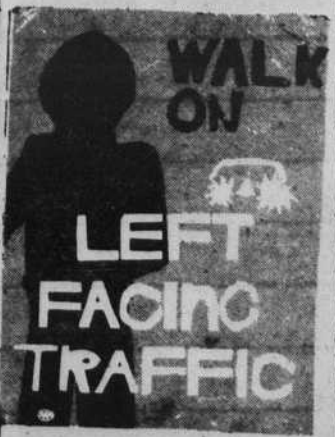
