

Dyke Harold Redmond has been appointed as a Scripture distribution representative by the American Bible Society to serve the Scripture needs of black churcehs.



Mr. Redmond is a recent graduate from UCLA where he received a Master of Arts degree. As part of his degree program he produced a videotape documentary titled "My Church, My People." It analyzed the central role black churches play in black communities.
