ASTROLOGICAL POINTS IN TIME AND BLACK AMERICANS—SLAVERY

The following is a special section of *You And The Stars* which finds astrological answers or possibilities for various significant points in the history of Black America.

Vandalism to Centel

For the second time in less than a week, telephone service between Las Vegas and Mt. Charleston was interrupted Saturday for an extended period due to vandals shooting at telephone facilities.

The latest incident occurred at approximately 6 p.m. Saturday when Central Telephone Company received an alarm indicating a facility failure at Mt. Charleston, said John Mallory, Centel division plant manager.

Mallory said a supervisor was dispatched to investigate and found that four shots had been fired into a metal box containing electronic equipment. One of the shots also struck a telephone cable, damaging most of the wires it contained. As a result of the damage, all but one of the circuits between Mr. Charleston and Las Vegas were knicked out of service until approximately 1:30 a.m. Sunday when Centel crews completed repairs.

Local service was not interrupted, but Mallory pointed out that Mt. Charleston residents must depend upon communications with Las Vegas for some types of emergency situations.

Mallory said loss of telephone facilities could result in loss of life if residents are unable to obtain assistance in case of emergency. He said also that deliberately damaging telephone facilities is a violation of state and federal laws.

Mallory encouraged residents to report acts of vandalism to law enforcement officials or Centel if they see such activities and, if possible obtain a complete description of the individuals involved including vehicles and license numbers.

The earlier shooting incident occurred on September 20, and resulted in a partial interruption of telephone service between Las Vegas and Mt. Charleston for a period of 16 hours.
