Only married couples will be considered and one parent must be in the home a full-time basis. The program provides a monthly salary in addition to a stipend, and clothing, food and medical allowances. "We're looking for very special couples who have the patience to see these kids through a very difficult time of their lives," said Williams.

She said the children, who are wards of the juvenile court, suffer a variety of either emotional, behavior or physical problems. Some are victims of neglect or child abuse. Currently, there are more than 25 children in such specialized foster homes, Williams
