

Foster Parents

The Nevada State Welfare Division is looking for people who are interested in becoming foster parents for children ages 3 to 18 with emotional and behavioral problems.

Social work supervisor Marguerite Williams said the legislature has authorized eight additional foster homes under a program first started two years ago in Nevada.

If accepted, foster parents would undergo a 6 to 8 week training program offered through Children's Behavioral Services before any children are placed. Only married couples will be considered and one parent must be in the home a full-time basis.

The program provides a monthly salary in addition to a stipend, and clothing, food and medical allowances.

"We're looking for very special couples who have the patience to see these kids through a very difficult time of their lives," said Williams.

She said the children, who are wards of the juvenile court, suffer a variety of either emotional, behavior or physical problems. Some are victims of neglect or child abuse.

Currently, there are more than 25 children in such specialized foster homes, Williams stated.
