Mrs. Rosemary K. Clarke, of the State Board of Education, Nevada, will visit Japan from October 19 to November 4 at the invita-tion of the Japan-United States Friendship Commission in a joint program with the Jap-anese Ministry of Education. As a member of a team of twelve American state school offic-tals representing the Council of Chief State a team of twelve American state school offic-ials representing the Council of Chief State School Officers, the National Association of State Boards of Education, and the National Congress of Parents and Teachers, she will be meeting with Ministry officials in Tokyo before proceeding to Nara, Sendai, Kyoto and other cities to observe schools and discuss common educational problems with Japanese counterparts.

The American fact-finding study group will be introduced to all aspects of Japanese elementary and secondary education through a two-week program of seminars, workshops and informal get-togethers arranged by the Ministry of Education. A return visit by Jap-anese educators to the United States is ten-tatively planned for the spring of 1978 in what

anese educators to the United States is ten-tatively planned for the spring of 1978, in what is expected to become a regular two-way ex-change leading to lasting ties between education officers in the two countries. The Japan-United States Friendship Com-mission, headquartered in Washington, D.C., was created by an Act of Congress in 1975 to administer a \$30 million federal trust fund for the promotion of scholary, cultural and artistic activities between the United States and artistic activities between the United States and Japan. The Commission helps to fund Japanese Studies at American universities and American Studies at Japanese universities and and makes select grants for exchanges and special projects in the arts, cultural communi-

cation and public affairs. Mrs. Clark is a director-at-large of the National Association of State Boards of Education, and resides in Las Vegas.
