Marina Wed. Night Fight

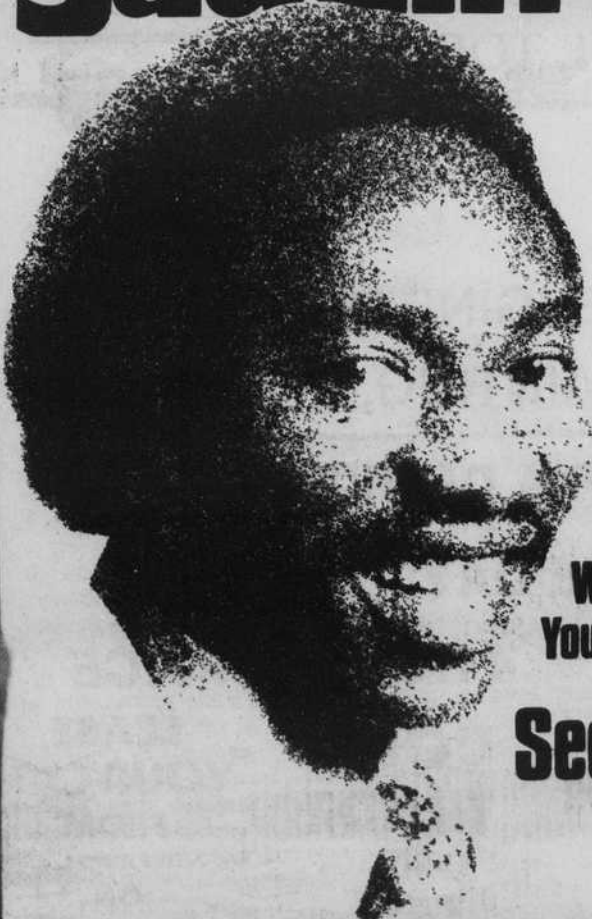
