

## HORDS OF LIFE **Biblical Inspiration** for The Week

"The Lord delights in you" -Isaiah 62:4

I. God has emotions. How do you think of God? Is God a father or perhaps (in our day of women's liberation) a mother? Is God active or pas-sive? Is God real? According to our text, doubtlessly surprising, to some people, God has emotions. We are made "like Him."

II. God can be happy. Just picture for a moment God laughing. What a different or startling picture that is! We sometimes think of God as becoming angry or judgmen-tal. But seldom do we picture God as engaging in delicious enjoyment. "The Lord de-

lights .... " III. God delights in you. The most important thing the text suggests about God's joy is that it comes through us. God delights in us and because of us. Both implications are significant.

Whatever joy we know of on the part of God comes to our awareness because of God's life in or within ourselves.

God's joy is also occasioned by the goodly things we do to make God happy. Have you helped God to be happy today?




