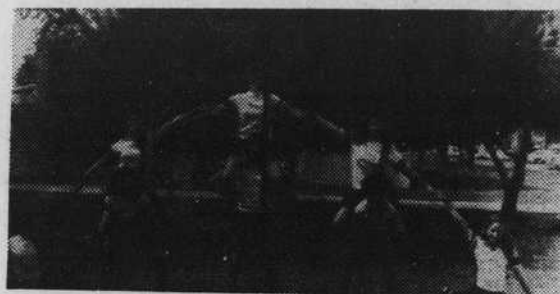

When I graduate, I plan to go to college and major in theatre & dance minor P.E. Song-leading may help me when I go to college.

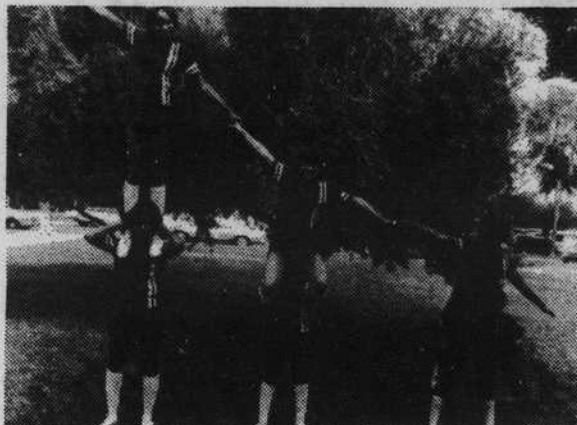
SHARON SCOTT
