NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the Board of Commissioners, Clark County, State of Nevada, will receive sealed bids from qualified contractors for the furnishing of labor and materials to construct an International Arrivals Roadway and Parking Lot and International Arrivals Facility, at the Office of the Clark County Purchasing Agent, 400 Las Vegas Boulevard South, Courthouse Annex, Las Vegas, Nevada until the hour of 2:45 p.m. on the 28th day of December, 1977 and said bids will be opened and publicly read at 3:00 p.m. in the Public Works Conference Room, Courthouse Annex, on the same day for:

PART "A": International Arrivals Roadway and Parking Lot, ADAP No. 8-32-0012-07.

PART "B": International Arrivals Facility.

The work which will be performed at McCarran International Airport, approximately four (4) miles south of Las Vegas city limits, State of Nevada, consists generally of the following:

PART "A" - ROADWAY AND LOT CONSTRUCTION

1. Remove and repave approximately 30,500 square feet (2,833 sq. m.) of existing entrance road.
2. Approximately 35,000 cubic yards (26,758 cu. m.) of imported fill.
3. Construct approximately 115,500 square feet (10,738 sq. m.) of roadway section.
4. Construct public parking lot, employee parking lot/baggage handling area.
5. Install approximately 550 (167.64 m) LO-HED R.-C.P. Class IV and drop inlets.
6. Street Lighting.
7. Signage.
8. Install 715 feet (217.93 m) of 10" (25.40 cm) Class 150 A.C. pipe, plus two fire hydrants.
9. Landscaping & irrigation.
10. Retaining walls and security fencing.

PART "B" - GENERAL BUILDING CONSTRUCTION

1. This portion of the project covers the entire architectural, structural, electrical and mechanical systems, materials and such other essentials as may be appropriate for the general construction of the building within the limits shown on the drawings on file at the Office of Camberio & Cam

The Part "A" (Roadway and Parking Lot) portion of the work in this contract shall be funded by the County of Clark in accordance with the terms and conditions of a grant agreement between the County of Clark and the United States under the Airport Development Aid Program. Pursuant to which the United States has agreed to pay a certain percentage of the costs of the project that are allowable project costs under the act. The United States will not be a party between the successful bidder and the County of Clark. This portion of the work, to be performed under the proposed contract shall be in accordance with these specifications and the "Uniform Standard Specifications for Public Works Construction Off-Site Improvements", Clark County Area Nevada, January 1966 and Special Provisions.

Special attention is directed to the following requirements which are included in the contract documents: The proposed contract is under and subject to, Executive Order 11246 of September 24, 1965, and to the Equal Employment Opportunity and Labor Standard Provisions. All labor on the project shall be paid no less than the minimum wage rates established by the U.S. Secretary of Labor in accordance with Decision NV77-5077, dated September 23, 1977.
