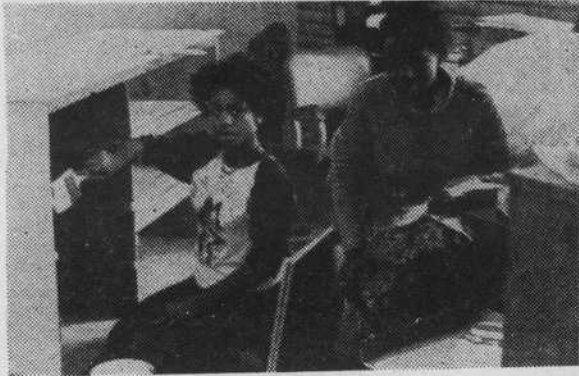

Lidia Martin paints a book case for the Easter Seal project while the exhausted supervisor looks on.



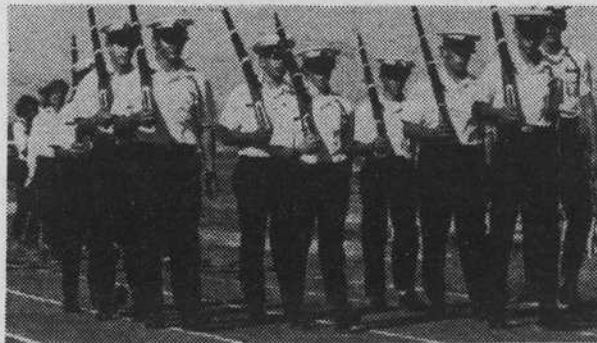

The NJORTC practices marching drills in back of Eldorado High School.



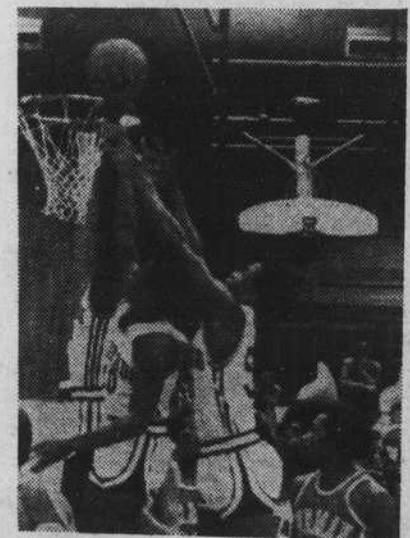
