Rebel Football Spring Practice

Nearly 100 prospects are expected on hand when UNLV opens Spring Practice in 1978 on the campus practice field at 3:30 p.m. Monday. It will be the first of the 20 allowable workouts which will conclude with the Sixth Annual UNLV Varsity-Alumni game on April 29, at 1:30 p.m. at the Las Vegas Silver Bowl, home site for the Rebel games.

"Spring practice is the time when we review the skills and fundamentals of football," comments head UNLV coach Tony Knap. He went on "It's time for the tough, contact-type action that you are really afraid to indulge in to a very great extent during the fall practices. We will be working on blocking, tackling, getting off quick, hitting, team offensive and defensive skills. We will also do some experimenting with position-switching by some players to help up determine more accurately where our players are best-suited to play this fall."

Coach Knap will begin his third spring practice with the Rebels, the first as a major college team for the school with "just" 10 previous seasons to its history.

In two years as the Rebel head coach, Knap has led UNLV to an 18-5 record, and this spring he will have the largest group ever to work with in preparation for the 1978 squad.

The daily workouts during the spring will be

held on Monday through Thursday at 3:30 p.m. with a scrimmage on Saturday mornings at approximately 9:30 a.m. All the drills will be held on the UNLV campus and the Alumni game will be held once again at the Las Vegas Silver Bowl, which is currently being expanded to 32,000 seats for the 1978 season.

In the spring squad roster are 52 returning lettermen along with 16 starters from last year's 9-2 team. UNLV also has nine junior college transfers who will be making their debuts with the Rebels.

All the proceeds of the Alumni game will go to the tutorial fund for Rebel athletes.

Football Season Tickets

UNLV's rapidly growing Football program has made us justly proud. In a five year period our season ticket sales have increased by 300% (from 933 in '73 to approximately 7800 in '77). With this year's new recruits and the return of many fine players under the able leadership of Coach Tony Knap we are looking forward to an excellent year.

Applications for renewal will be mailed to previous season ticket holders in the near future. If there is any question regarding tickets, individuals may stop by the UNLV Ticket Office located in the McDermott Physical Education and we will be happy to help them.
