If one had free choice, he would scour the city for our Black youth as well as all children in order to find for each child:

A teacher dedicated as a clergyman, selfish as a family doctor, sensitive as an artist, skillful as a master craftsman, ready as a good parent to understand, to sacrifice, to serve, to support, to forgive.

A teacher committed to the faith that, while no child is exactly like another, for each the level of achievement can be raised, aspirations stirred, potential talents discovered and developed.

A teacher bound in conscience to help each child find his own dignity.

The question now is, "Does Herbert Gerson Housing Project have this type of personnel working with our children?" I think this matter needs immediate attention. A closer look needs to be taken at the quality of the program and at the people who comprise the staff there. Wake up West Las Vegas! Wake up residents of Herbert Gerson Projects! This is your community at stake. Your children's education and training is on the chopping block. Stop the axe NOW before it is lowered.

Stage and screen star Pearl Bailey read "The Oath of Positivity" on the NBC telecast of the Black America Pageant last September. The pageant is now offering free copies of the oath to the general public.

Free copies of "The Oath of Positivity," the official creed of the Miss Black America Pageant, are now available to the public.

The offer was announced by J. Morris Anderson, the pageant's founder and director, at his headquarters in Philadelphia, Pa. The oath is an excerpt from "The Seeds

of Positivity," a book that Anderson wrote to help Miss Black America contestants think and act like winners.

Baby Examinations

The Jackson Street Clinic is expanding its services to include well baby examinations on the third Thursday of each month. These exams are available at no charge for infants and children up through 4 years. The purpose of well baby exams is to keep children healthy and to encourage parents to enjoy their children as they grow and develop.

The Public Health Nurse checks the children for normal growth and development, as well as any signs of illness. Immunizations are given as necessary. If special problems are observed, proper referrals are made.

It is necessary to have an appointment for a well baby exam. Call the Jackson Street Clinic at 648-1850 during clinic hours 12:30 p.m. to 4 p.m., Monday through Friday. Appointments can also be made by calling the Health District at 385-1291, ext.304.

The Jackson Street Clinic at 402 Jackson also offers free immunizations to school age children as well as preschoolers.

Early screening exams are available to Title XIX recipients with a medical card.

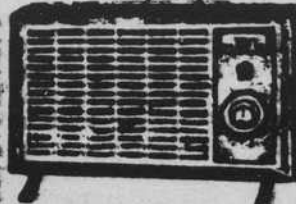
