UNLV Baseball

UNLV came out on top Sunday when they beat Lewis-Clark 10-1. Junior righthander Mark Jamison, now 3-2 on the season, walked three Warrior batters and struck out four on his way to the win, and his third complete game in five starts.

McHenry hit his fourth home run of the season in the sixth inning, driving Slavenski ahead of him.

The Rebels continued their assault on the NCAA record for most double plays in a season. The UNLV defense turned two twin killings against Lewis-Clark to bring its season total to 48, just 19 short of the collegiate record with 17 games remaining in the schedule.

On Monday UNLV played Lewis-Clark in a doubleheader. The first game went to the Rebels 6-5 while the second went to Lewis-Clark 5-4.

Southpaw Herb Pryor established an all time record for most wins in a season by a UNLV pitcher, picking up his ninth victory of the year. The 26 year-old Pryor, in relief of starter Mike Mumms, also passed the 400 innings pitched mark for his career in running his record to 9-3. This split makes the Rebels 25-15 on the season while the Warriors are now 29-7.

The first game went into a 10th inning. In that inning, Mike Randolph cracked a single. Left fielder Mike Slavenski then laid down a sacrifice bunt which Christensen fielded and

threw to second in an attempt to pick off the lead runner. But the throw was late and both players were safe on the fielders choice.

After Christensen wild pitched the runners to second and third, he walked designated hitter Ray Perry to load the bases.

With the outfield playing in to cut off the run at the plate with none out, second baseman Vance McHenry dropped a sinking line drive just in front of Warrior right fielder Mike Scott to drive in Randolph with the winning run.

The second game was finished in almost total darkness, and was less spectacular.

The Rebels next play United States International University in a single game Friday, and again Saturday in a doubleheader scheduled to start at noon.

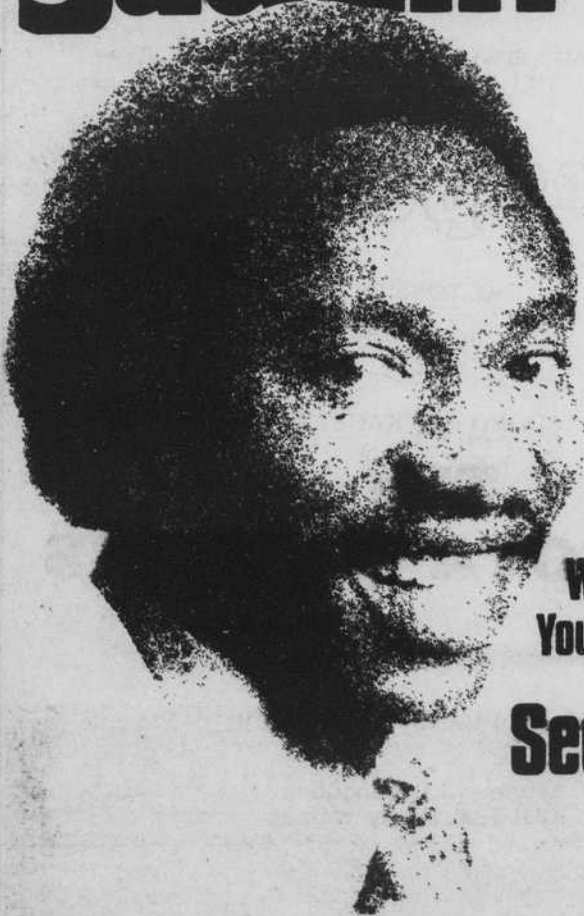
