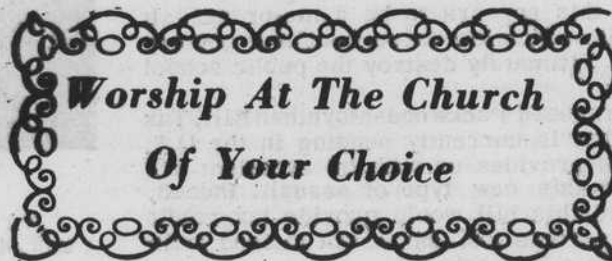

WORDS OF LIFE Biblical Inspiration For The Week

"The place on which you stand is holy ground."
—Exodus 3:5

1. "The earth is the Lord's." Hence it is holy. When we say, "All things come of thee, O Lord; and of thine own have we given thee," it is but another way of saying, "Holy things for the Holy." Whatever God has touched is holy. The earth itself is hallowed ground. It reflects its maker's hand, heart and mind.

2. "And God said that it was good." Goodliness and godliness are more than cognate or similar terms; they represent the one and same reality. If it is good truly,

then it is of God. God saw the earth; and of it He said that it was good.

3. Where you walk is holy. To be holy means to be set apart for and by God. Where you walk and stand has been set apart for you to do special things for the Lord, the particular things which reflect God's will.

Wherever God's messengers go, then, is holy. The ground upon which they travel is hallowed. God's saints move, it has been said, leaving behind a trail bursting with God's glory.
