WORDS OF LISE Biblical Inspiration For The Beek

"The place on which you stand is holy ground."
—Exodus 3:5

1. "The earth is the Lord's." Hence it is holy. When we say, "All things come of thee, O Lord; and of thine own have we given thee," it is but another way of saying, "Holy things for the Holy." Whatever God has touched is holy. The earth itself is hallowed ground. It reflects its maker's


Fair are the meadows, er still the woodlands, Robed in the blooming garb
