The Las Vegas VOICE Newspaper is now registering people to vote, with NO federal funding -- NO grants -- NO one working for the State or City -- or ANY federal agency.

The Voice is doing this with the help of Marion Bennett and the VOICE staff alone. Rev. Bennett asked the VOICE to have a representative registering voters, so that the people in West Las Vegas, who are unable to get down town, could register.

Please come to the VOICE to register. We would like to show the Whites the the Black vote is important.

I feel this was a good idea that Rev. Bennett came up with to get more blacks back to registering and voting. We have agreed because there are ONLY 18% of the

black population in Las Vegas registered to vote, and we feel that there should be 100% registered to vote, but even more important, 100% of the Blacks should VOTE!!!

We do not ask you to come to our home to register, but to our office, which is open at our own expense, without outside assistance. In fact, our staff will go -- on their own time -- on Sunday, or whenever asked to do so -- to your place, for instance Your Church -- to register you after Church Services are over.

No particular politician can say they own the VOICE, because they do NOT own the VOICE. The VOICE is privately owned, with NO outside aide.
