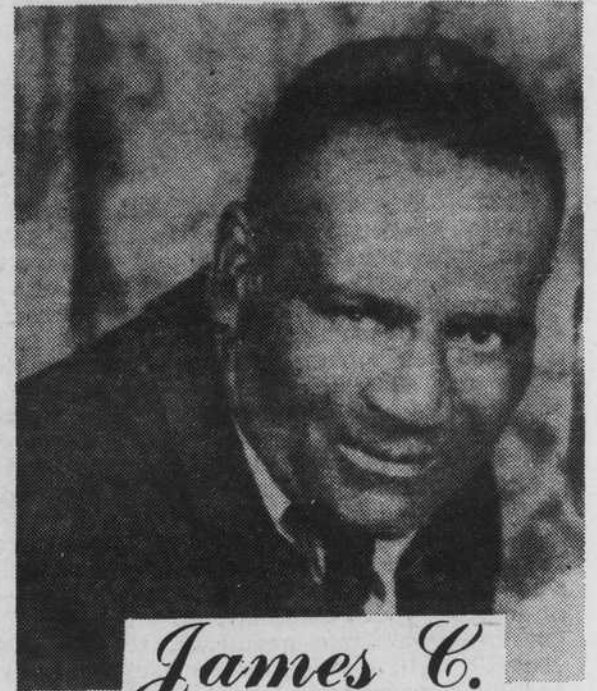


James C. Young, Jr.

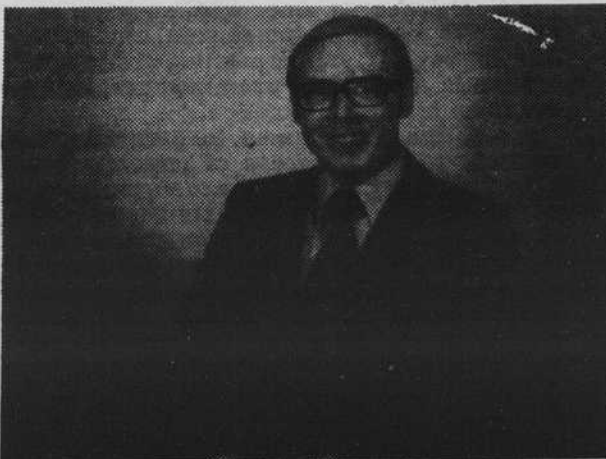
2. We have the gift of power. Hence we can say, "I can do all things..." God's power enables us to do all things consistent with God's

will.

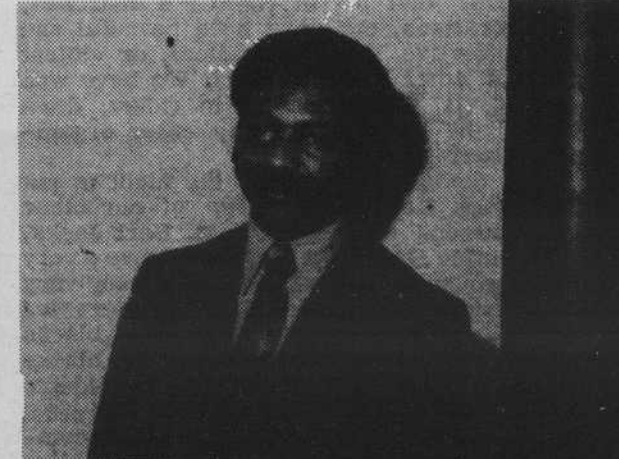
3. We have the gift of love. Hence we have life's greatest gift. God is love, so St. John tells us. To have love is to have no less than God.
