Spanish poetry has a lyri-cal quality about it which is nearly impossible to attain in English. Reading the two language versions side by side hence proves tremendously rewarding.

The poetry in this volume is among the most powerful and imaginative that Americans of an English-speaking background may ever read. It is a rich and rare experience for lovers of song and admirers of feeling for things which seem almost beyond the capacity to express

This bi-hngual anthology offers a fine sampling of the poetry of Spanish-speaking Latin America from the times before the coming of Christopher Columbus to the
