## Civil Rights Act

The Rehabilitation Act of 1973 was widely hailed as a milestone piece of legislation, comparable in its implications to the Civil Rights Act of 1964.

Last year, when Secretary of Health, Education, and Welfare Joseph A. Califano, Jr., issued a regulation pursuant to Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act, he declared it would "open a new world of equal opportunity for more than 35 million handicapped Americans."

Disabled children and young people have more specific education guarantees under the Education for All Handicapped Children Act of 1975.

Such laws and regulations make clear the federal government's determination to end discrimination of handicapped people in any aspect of national life that is supported in full or in part by U.S. tax dollars. And, that's significant progress by any measure society chooses.

But implementation of the law's wide-ranging provisions will require a major shift in public attitudes toward the disabled. As one disabled individual puts it: "Others must begin to see us as people—not as crutches and wheelchairs and canes."

Public commitment is necessary if we are to put a stop to the discrimination, the demeaning practices and the injustices that have afflicted the nation's handicapped citizens. And that kind of commitment is based upon public awareness of the problem and how to solve it.

That's what National Handicapped Awareness Week, May 14-20, is all about. Sponsored by the Nevada Easter Seal Society and its affiliates across the country, this program—now in its fourth year—seeks to sensitize the public to the needs and rights of persons with disabilities. For too long, people with handicaps have been denied the rights the rest of us take for granted. It's high time to give a helping hand to the Nevada Easter Seal Society and other organizations who have worked to build a fair shake for disabled people into the system.
