A review of The Camera Never Blinks: Adventures of a TV Journalist by Dan Rather (with Mickey Herskowitz) (William Morrow and Company, New York) 320 pages-hard cover, \$10.00.

For those who want to read for fun-and incidentally for enlightenment-here is a readable, intelligent, insightful and fun-filled book. It tells (with the help of another writer) the adventures of Dan Rather whose name has become synonymous with courageous journalism in our present day.
