Promoter DON KING will donate \$50,000 of his earnings from his World Boxing Council Heavyweight championship fight between Champion Ken Norton and Challenger Larry Holmes to selected Black charities.

The Norton-Holmes championship fight will held at Caesars Palace in Las Vegas on

Friday night June 9.

King will donate \$10,000 each to the National Black United Fund, THE NATIONAL NEWSPAPER PUBLISHERS ASSOCIATION. The NAACP, Operation PUSH and the Martin Luther King Center for Social Change.

King made the announcement at a major San Francisco Press Conference. He was flanked by Dr. Carlton B. Goodlett. pro-

flanked by Dr. Carlton B. Goodlett, pro-minent San Francisco physician and president of both the National Black United Fund and the National Newspaper Publishers Association, and Lynda Anderson, Associate Director of NBUF.

The donations will be made as designated contributions to the National Black United Fund. King is a member of the Board of Directors of the National Black United Fund. He is also Chairman of the Special Gifts Committee.

"I am giving as a gesture to affirm the need of all blacks and indeed all Americans at all levels to give to advance the dignity and respect of black people, and all people"
King said. "These donations, are only a
drop in the bucket but through them I appeal

to my fellow Americans to put something in so that we get something out."

"Don King has always been a trailblazer"
Goodlett said. "But this gesture is so timely and so needed that it is historic. Don is coming forward at a time when charitable giving is at a crucial crossword. giving is at a crucial crossroad. I laud his generosity and assure him that posterity will certainly do honor to his kindness and commitment."

## **BUSINESS IN THE BLACK**

Pork barrelling is an old trick of politicians to put a piece of the federal money pie back in each individual district. Black voters had hoped to have their unemployment roles re-lieved with the election of James Earl Carter, Jr. to the Presidency of the United States.

The trade was votes for jobs, pure and simple permanent jobs. Good-by relief, good-by welfare rolls. Now comes the deal, two years later and prone to poverty. The President has put forward an \$11.4 billion jobs service bill obstensibly for blacks, but destined for anyone wishing to return to the welfare rolls.

The essence of the bill is leave raking until the end of congressional elections and perhaps the 1980 Presidential election. Black Muslims will not touch pork. Black voters could vomit from the implications of the President's job welfare bill.
