AN UNFORGETTABLE **JOURNEY**

A review of The Camera Never Blinks: Adventures of a TV Journalist by Dan Rather (with Mickey Herskowitz) (William Morrow and Company, New York) 320 pages-hard cover, \$10.00.

For those who want to read for fun-and incidentally for enlightenment-here is a readable, intelligent, insightful and fun-filled book. It tells (with the help of another writer) the adven-tures of Dan Rather whose name has become synonymous with courageous jour-

nalism in our present day. The book is not startling in any of its conclusions and is by no means worthy of a perpetual place among one's permanent library books. But it is an exciting diversion.

This book takes us to out of the way places and takes us back to unforgettable scenes in our national and international life where Dan Rather has been on the side

lines as a reporter. In this respect, as we see through the eyes and words of Dan Rather, we too have a front row seat to see and to sense what Dan Rather saw and felt.

This is a book you will like and you'll become just a bit closer to Dan Rather, the remarkably warm human being, too.
