## WORDS OF LIFE

### Biblical Inspiration For The Week

"He who trusts in the Lord is safe."—Proverbs 29:25

1. *Have you ever feared for your safety?* Most of us do. Beyond the taking of reasonable precautions, we are tense and are high blood-pressure-prone. Now while some fears may be reasonably founded, a life characterized by fear is unnatural. It is not as God means it to be.

2. *Have you ever really trusted in the Lord?* One person recently with graying hair, who was always considered to be religious, remarked: "I have always asked God to *help me*. I have never acted or really felt like God Himself was sufficient; that 'underneath are God's everlasting arms.'" Late in life, that person had come to know that "trust in God" means that we must simply surrender our lives to Him.

3. *In God we find safety.* "Commit the way unto Him . . . and trust in Him. And He will give thee thy heart's desire." That is the assurance of safety. One gets that assurance clearly each Christmas season as we listen particularly to Miss Marian Anderson's singing on recordings of portions of "The Messiah."

### Prayer Poem

The assurance of God's provision for our safety comes through clearly in John Greenleaf Whittier's hymn "I know not what the future hath."

Listen to and reflect up its timelessly re-assuring words.

*I know not what the future hath  
 Of marvel or surprise,  
 Assured alone that life and death  
 God's mercy underlies.*

*I know not where God's islands lift  
 Their fronded palms in air;  
 I only know I cannot drift  
 Beyond His love and care.*

In the congregation of God's worshipping people, we come most quickly to know God's assurance of His care, that we are safe in Him.
