This cannot be accomplished, he said, by "coddling criminals."

"There is nothing basically wrong with the law enforcement program we have in Clark County, except that we do not have enough."

He said that the rising crime rate is one of the major concerns of citizens today, and that the reduction of this rate "is not only important for the protection and safety of our residents and visitors, but also for the protection of our major industry . . . tourism."

As to how a governor could take a role of leadership in the fight against crime, Schofield said he would seek more budgeted funds for law enforcement, encourage the legislature to enact tougher laws and appoint strong judges to fill vacancies.

Schofield said he favors capital punishment.
